Strategy "Education 2024-2026" of the Faculty of Medicine

Summary of the mandate from the Faculty Executive Board to the Teaching Committee dated 18.10.2023

(1) Vertical and horizontal integration in education

Support for projects to improve the cross-linking of teaching content.

(2) Evaluation and performance-based allocation of teaching funds (PBA)

Evaluation concept for the 6 academic years of human medicine (harmonization, focusing, reduction). Evaluate the possibility of PBA for the following 3 areas: University Clinics of the Inselspital, teaching/research institutes, service institutes. Develop evaluation criteria for the PBA for the University Clinics of the Inselspital and submission to the Faculty.

(3) Planetary Health Curriculum

Align the new learning objectives on Planetary Health in the revised PROFILES with the curriculum in Bern. Integrate the topic into existing courses and, if necessary, establish new content.

(4) Faculty Development Education (FD-E)

FD-E Monitoring. Formulate minimum requirements at the clinic level. Pilot an "outreach teaching team" using existing training facilities at the University Clinics of the Inselspital. Support academic careers in teaching. Didactic and organizational support and better recognition of student representatives on teaching committees. Support for outstanding students.

(5) Interprofessional education

Provide an overview of existing interprofessional courses. Foster exchange with other medical educational institutions in the Bern region. Introduction of level-appropriate, interprofessional teaching formats in both study programs (Bachelor/Master).

(6) Digitalization of medical education

Digitization of attendance records. Evaluate a system for digitizing on-the-job assessments and/or an ePortfolio. Develop digital forms of learning. Monitor the impact of artificial intelligence on teaching.
